just before the bell rang mr. Nielsen said, "Don't forget that your science projects are do a week from today.

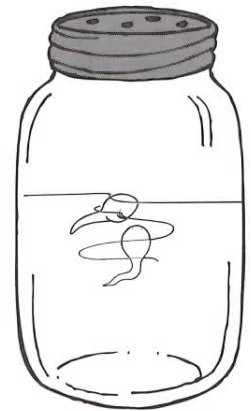

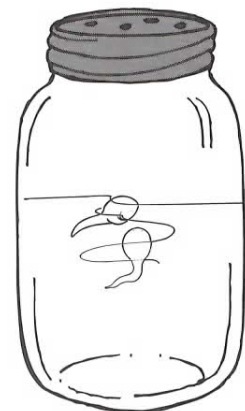
