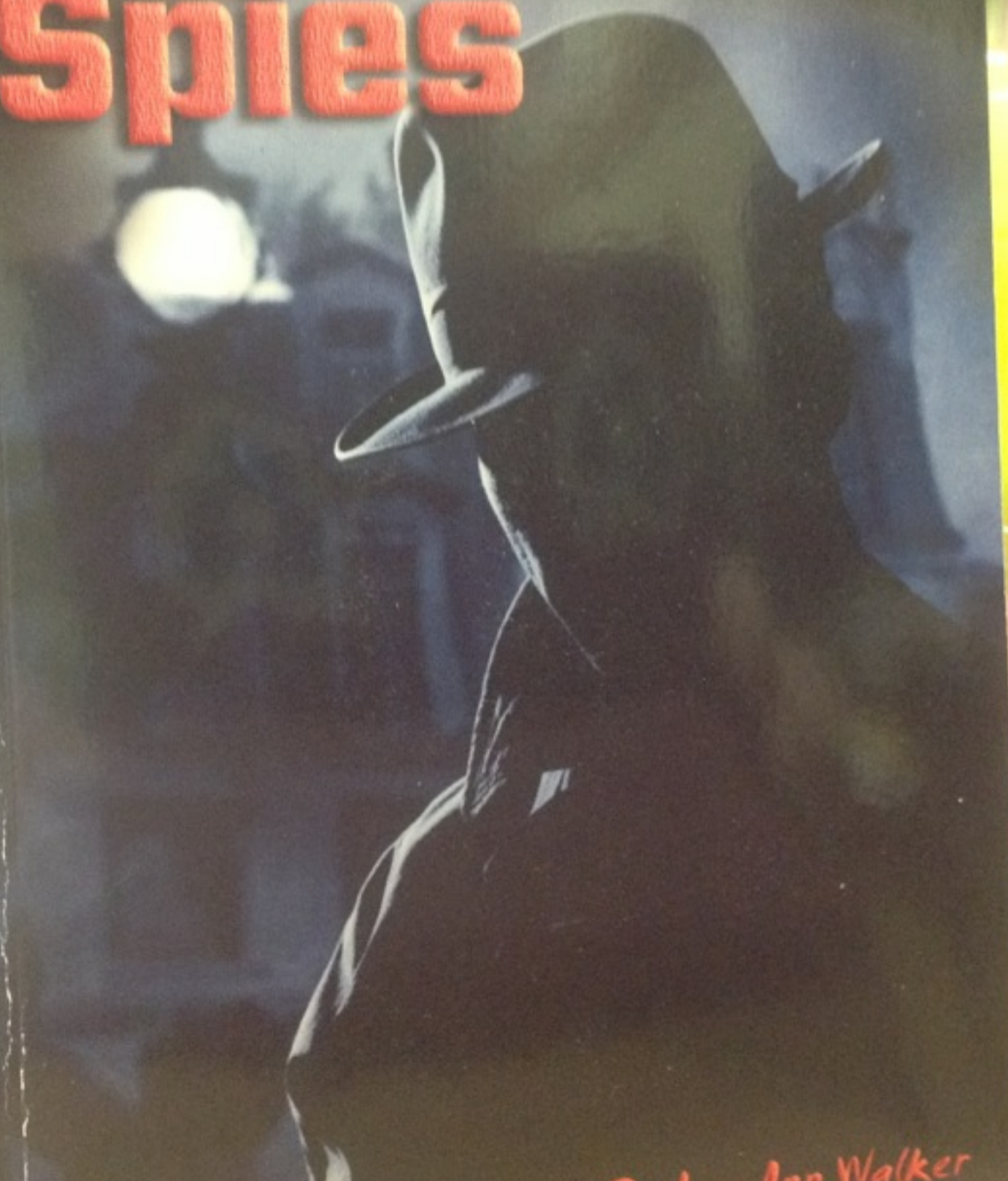

# GHGR 3.1.2 - Thinking About What You Know Before Reading

- I can identify the topic of a book before reading.
  - I can activate knowledge about the topic of a book.
- \* **Look for words in the title to help identify the topic.**
  - \* **Analyze the cover art / photograph to think of how it helps identify the topic.**
  - \* **One way to activate BK is to use the book title and cover art.**

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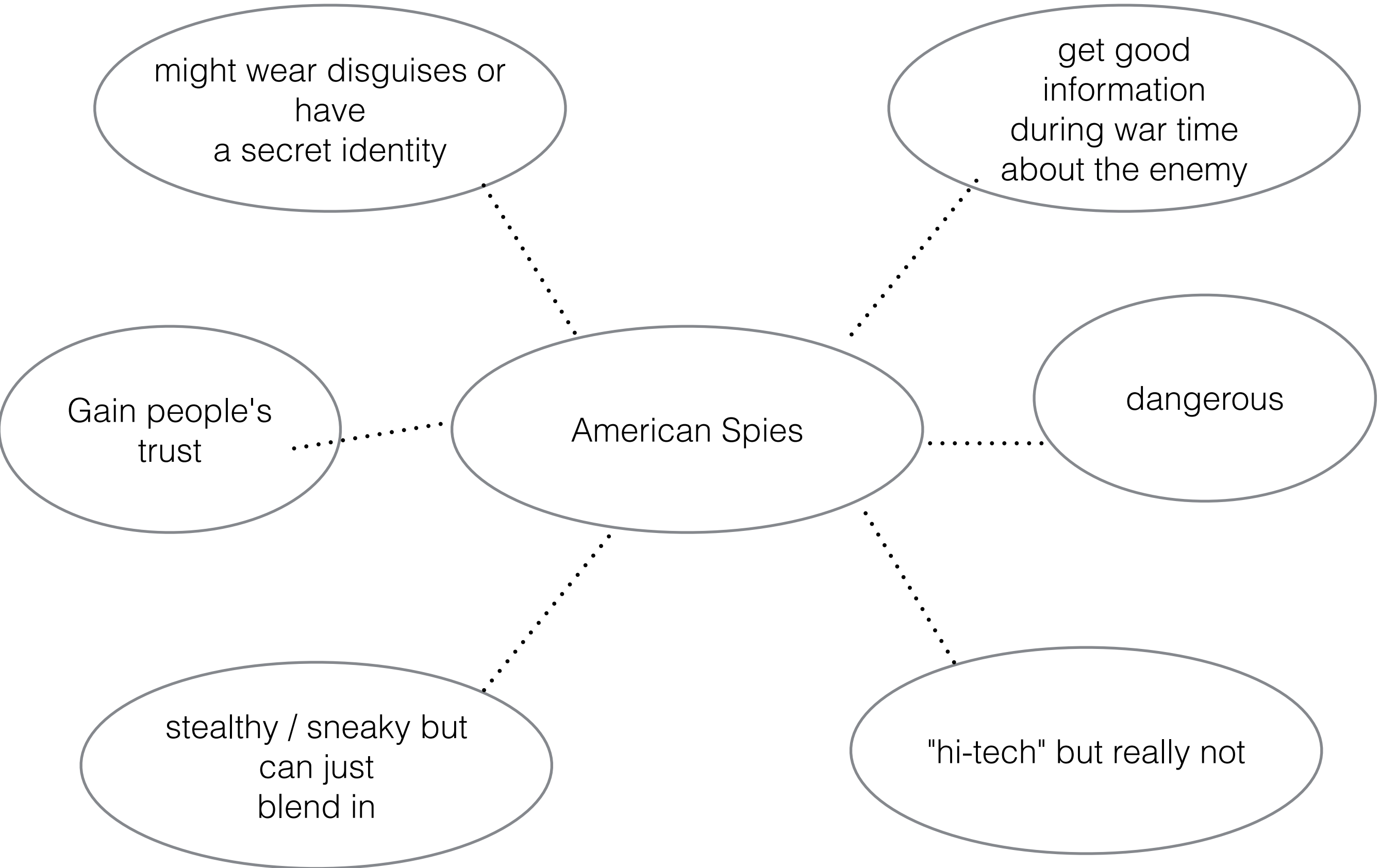
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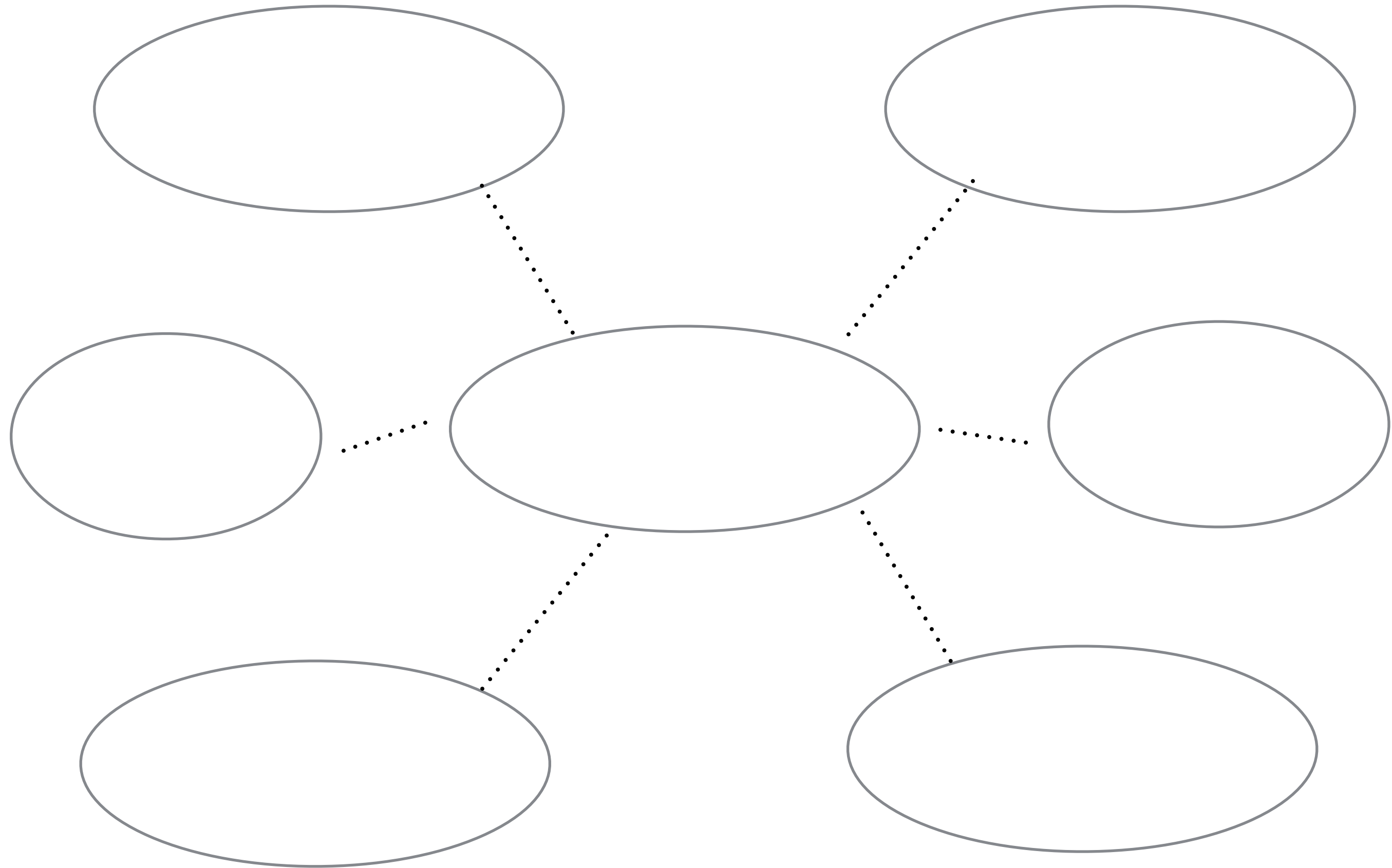
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# GHGR 3.1.3 - Considering Your Purpose for Reading

- I can identify a purpose for wanting (or have) to read a book.
- I can figure out what background information is most helpful.

**\* 3 Purposes of Writing - Inform, Entertain, & Persuade. As a reader you usually don't read to be persuaded, but you do read to be informed (learn), and entertained (enjoyment).**

\* There are different types of clocks today (2 or more hands) or digital.

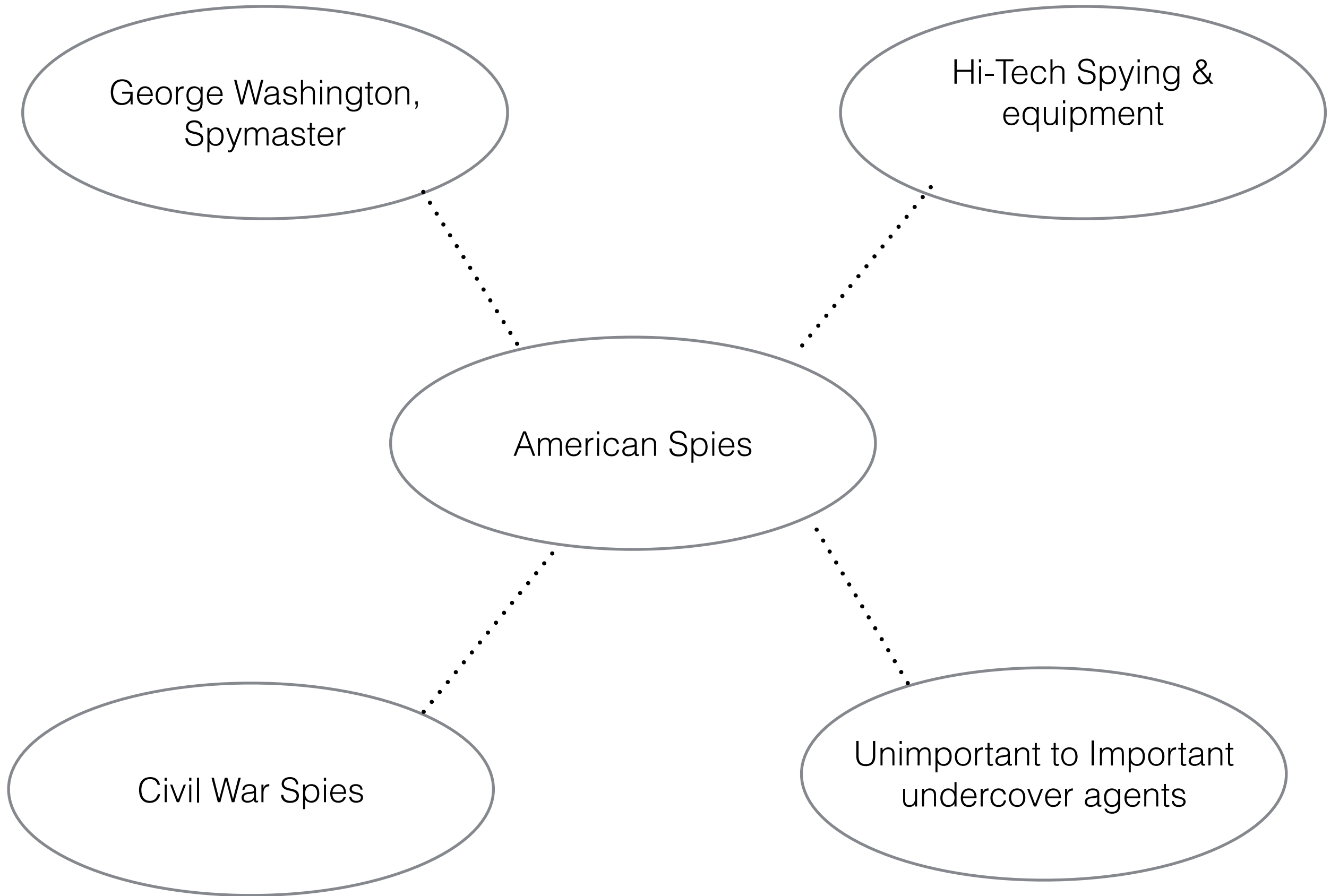
# GHGR 3.1.4 - Previewing to Activate Background Knowledge

- I can preview a book (including title of contents page, visuals, captions, headings, and boldface type).
- I can identify, after previewing, specific BK that will enhance my understanding.

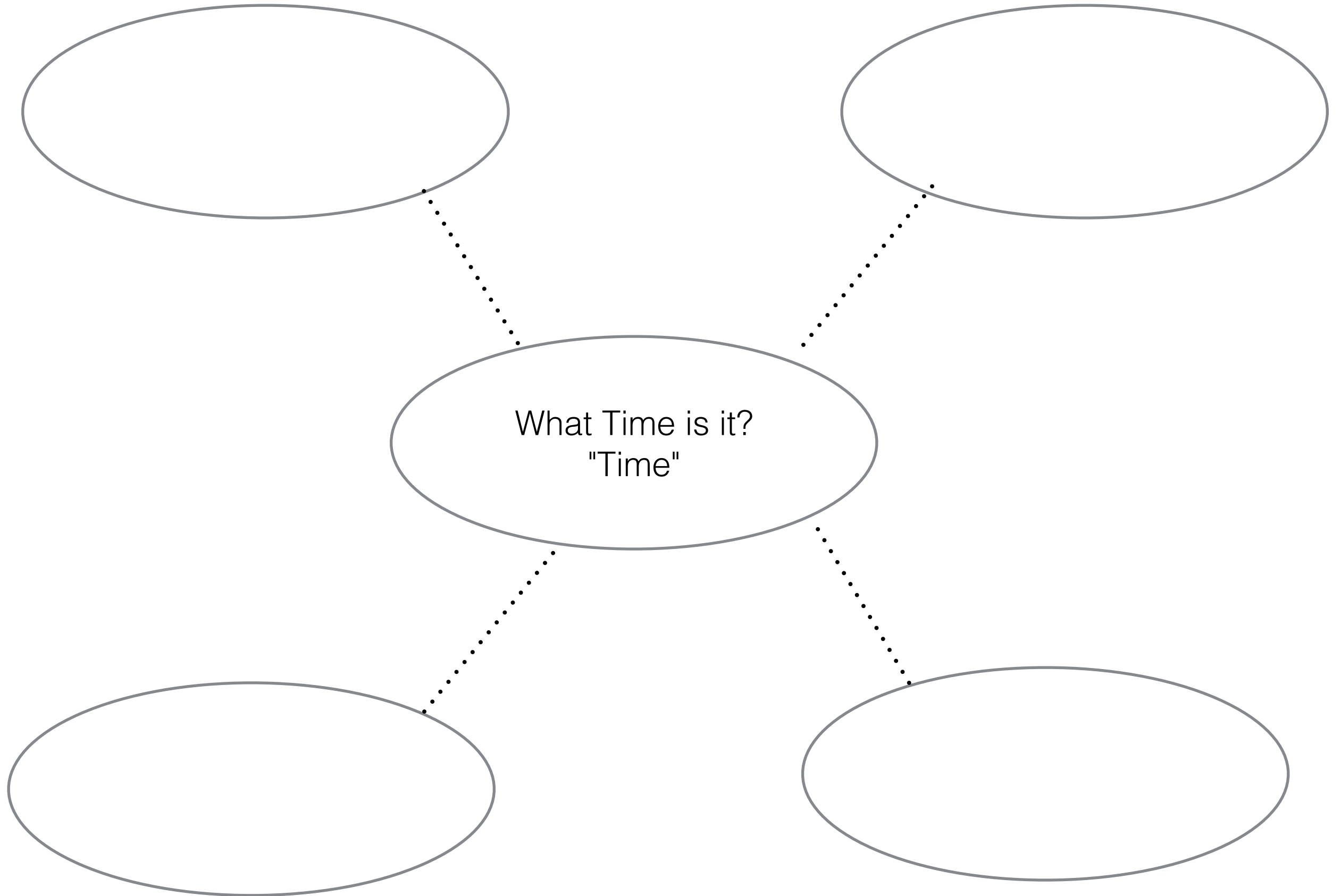
**\* Previewing a book is like watching a movie trailer, it should give you a big idea of what it's about but very few small details.**

**\* Use visuals & text features to connect.**

## Steps to Activating Background Knowledge

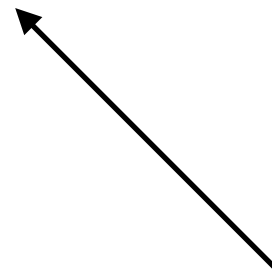
Identify the topic of the book.



Think about what you already know about the topic. Record that knowledge on a concept web.



Preview the visuals, contents page, and text to help you figure out what BK is most important.



Decide on your purpose for reading the book. Figure out what BK will be most helpful for that.



Revise the concept web
